



## SPECIFIC FORMS OF EDUCATION IMPLEMENTATION

The prosperity of the homeland, the development of the country depend on the well-educated, highly spiritual and broad-minded youth. Today, only highly educated, modern-thinking, intellectually developed and professionally trained youth can be the most important condition and guarantee of qualitative, rapid and innovative development, it is they who can ensure the great future of the country.

As the head of our state emphasized, the most noble goals that lie ahead of us are the great future of our

country, our tomorrow, our free and prosperous life, and the place that Uzbekistan will occupy in the world community in the 21st century – all of this, first of all, depends on what kind of people the new generation, our children who are growing up, will become. These words, spoken with a long-term perspective, vividly illustrate the essence of the state policy implemented in our country during the years of independence. The priority direction of this policy is to care for the upbringing of a physically healthy, spiritually mature, highly



intellectually capable, modernly educated, independent-thinking, and confident generation.

In particular, the fundamental improvement of the content of education, the widespread introduction of new pedagogical technologies into the field, and the priority given to improving the qualifications of teachers and educators and encouraging their work have created an opportunity for our youth to receive education and upbringing in conditions that meet world standards [1].

Today, our republic has 9,779 secondary schools, 1,396 vocational colleges, and 141 academic lyceums, whose educational and production rooms and laboratories are equipped with the most modern technical equipment. The state program "Year of a Perfect Generation" consists of 11 directions and 102 items, which include the development of children and young people, improvement of the legal and normative framework aimed at protecting their rights, protection of reproductive health of mothers and children, and improvement of the health care system. It is intended to create conditions for the all-round development of the younger generation based on strengthening its material and technical base. Since sport is an important condition for human development, serious attention was paid to the issue of widespread involvement of young people in physical education and sports during the years of independence, including among children and adolescents, a number of comprehensive

programs for the wide development of sports, especially in rural areas, were adopted. Education of the young generation in the spirit of loyalty to the motherland, among them, a three-stage competition system in the formation of a healthy lifestyle - "Umid nihollar", "Barkamol Avlod" and "Universiade" sports games have a special place. Importantly, these competitions are for students from the first grade to graduates of higher educational institutions-covers all representatives of the younger generation [2].

In this regard, the health of children from low-income families, orphans and disabled children, as well as creating conditions for them to engage in physical education, has always been in the focus of our state's attention.

Approved current educational directions include 348 specialties and 840 professions in the classification of secondary special, vocational education specialties and professions. 268 specialties including 712 professions are currently being trained in our country.

During the period of independence, special attention was paid to improving the system of academic lyceums and vocational colleges. In 2008, 169 vocational colleges were built and 23 academic lyceums were put into operation. On November 23, 2005, the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan Adopted the "Model Regional Program for the High-Quality Training and Labor Utilization of Graduates of Vocational Colleges and Academic



Lyceums in 2006-2010." Based on this program, each administrative structure

Territorial programs that take into account the specific characteristics of regions and districts were developed, coordinating councils headed by governors and including representatives of state and public organizations were established under the hokims.

In the process of education, students are taught to think logically and draw rational conclusions in the process of developing their intellectual activity and thinking. J. Piaget, in his scientific research, worked on the concept of intelligence and defined the concepts of thinking and intelligence. The word intelligence comes from the Latin *intellestus* - mind, thinking activity, means studying the environment with the help of the mind [3].

We often come across the concept of a person with intellectual potential. It is important to properly explain this concept to students. It is necessary to teach how to make a clear decision in a certain place, to study the problem as a whole or in parts, and to show the ways to make the right decision. The famous psychologist S.L. Rubinstein, studying

the problem of intelligence, divides it into two parts.

1) The ability to correctly study the environment. 2) Correctly perceive oneself in this space. In the 21st century, intelligence is being studied as a universal mental ability [4]. When a person studies a certain problem, he or she is able to perceive and he makes decisions through logical thinking, works to achieve the goal he has set for himself. "A person with a properly formed intellectual ability makes good use of his worldview, mental abilities, "Strives for maturity. Creates opportunities for intellectual new knowledge to make the right decisions in emergency situations".

In conclusion, as a result of large-scale measures implemented in accordance with the State National Program, the quality of education in educational institutions in our Republic, along with the creation of modern conveniences for organizing educational and educational work, has been improved, and the spirit of patriotism has been formed in our youth, thus, arming oneself with national history is becoming the need of the hour.

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
